We were also looking for animals and their homes such as; squirrels, mice, badgers, hedgehogs and rabbits.



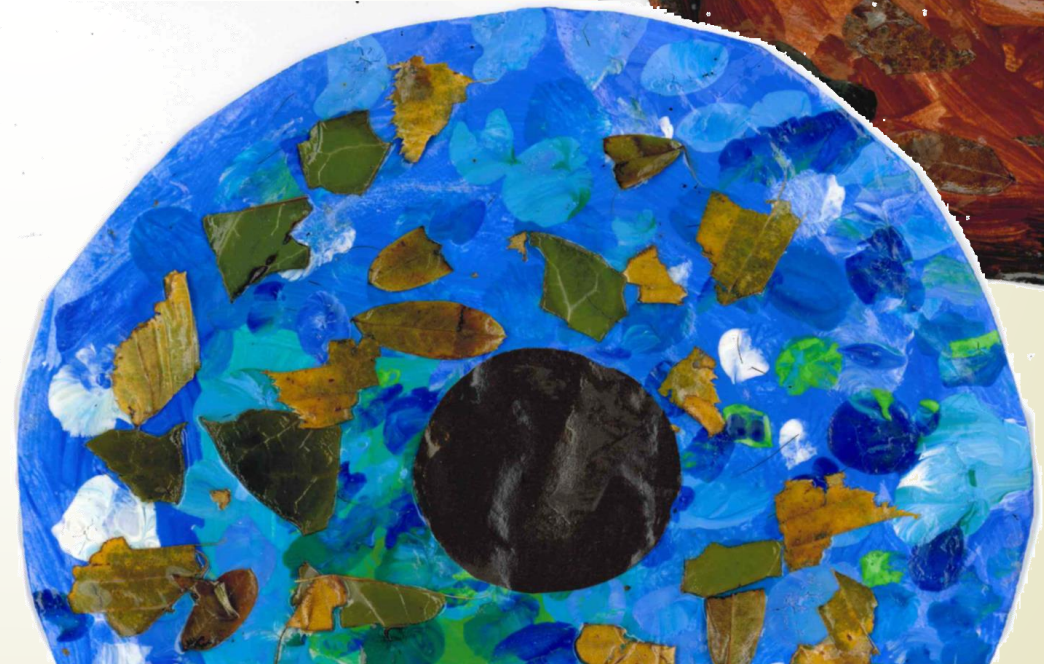
The children collected Autumn treasures and used them in the classroom to make their own Autumn creatures and paintings.

Reception Class 3

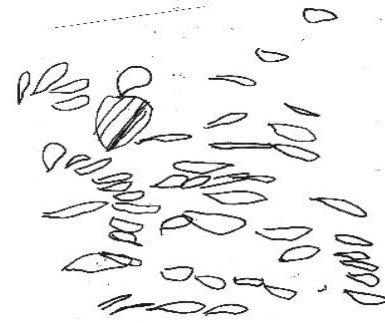
We explored pumpkins.
